FS4EU Pre Forum 2022:The new sustainability regulation: how to integrate it into food safety?

On 15th December 2022, the first physical FS4EU event took place in Brussels co-organized by Euro Coop.

The **FS4EU Pre-forum 2022** is a multi-stakeholder event where FS4EU project's partners (<u>FoodDrinkEurope</u>, <u>Euro Coop</u>, <u>FAVV-AFSCA</u>, <u>WUR — Wageningen University & Research</u>), key actors from the EU Food Safety System (<u>Copa-Cogeca</u>, <u>SAFE</u>, <u>FEBA</u>) and EU projects coordinators shared different perspectives from policy, industry, consumer, research, initiatives, and finally from the young generation (<u>Safeconsume</u>, <u>Humyco</u>, <u>One Health EJP Toxosources</u>, <u>Titan</u>, <u>Holifood</u>, <u>FoodPaths</u>, <u>UGENT — EUFORA 2022/2023</u>).


Researchers, food safety authorities and food business operators had the opportunity to access directly to primary information and to contribute with their experiences, ideas and future perspectives to food safety policies and regulations based on scientific evidence. On the other hand, the consumers were informed on what's happening to improve food safety in Europe, while being active actors of the debate on food safety issues and next regulations.

The knowledge gathered from the event will feed the EU Food Safety Forum that will take place in late 2023.

On 7th December 2022, the 2nd edition of the Risk Assessment Research Assembly (RARA), organized by EFSA, gathered in Berlin funders, policy/decision makers and leading food safety researchers to stimulate alignment between national and EU research funding, showcasing how research outputs can support the achievement of Sustainable Development Goals and the Green Deal. Veronica Lattanzio, FS4EU Coordinator presented the project to the audience, explaining how it is contributing to the creation of an **engagement framework** to close the gap between reserchers and risk assessors. Lessons learned from the FS4EU exeperience and the way forward were in depth discussed.

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Avian influenza cases in poultry and water birds on the rise

While the number of HPAI virus detections in sea bird breeding colonies came down since the previous reporting period (June to September 2022), the number of cases in water birds and poultry has increased. The rise in the number of outbreaks in poultry since the summer is suspected to be linked to the spread of the virus via water birds.











Addressing the need for safe, nutritious and sustainable food: Outcomes of the "ONE – Health, Environment & Society – Conference 2022

On 21–24 June 2022, the European Food Safety Authority, together with the European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control, the European Chemicals Agency, the European Environment Agency, the European Medicines Agency, and the Joint Research Centre of the European Commission, held the "ONE – Health, Environment & Society – Conference 2022". The conference brought together experts and stakeholders to reflect on how scientific advice related to food safety and nutrition will need to develop to respond to a fast-changing world. The event also explored how institutions that provide such advice should best prepare for the challenges ahead, and how they can contribute to policy targets and societal demands for safe, nutritious and sustainable food.
