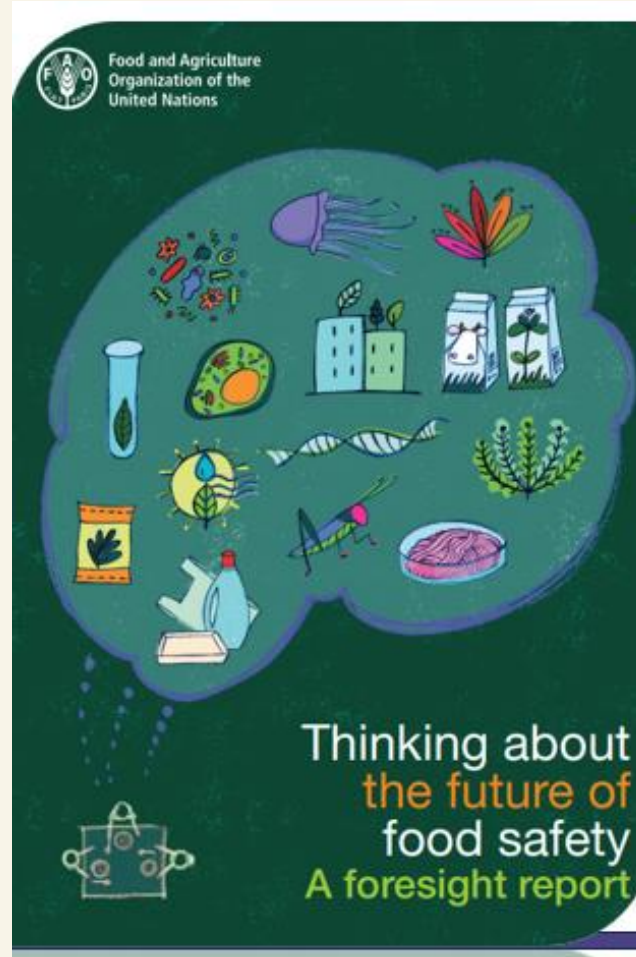


CATALYSE

FACILITATE


Establish a unified networking platform for stakeholders to share information and follow up on innovations and their implementation progress.
