



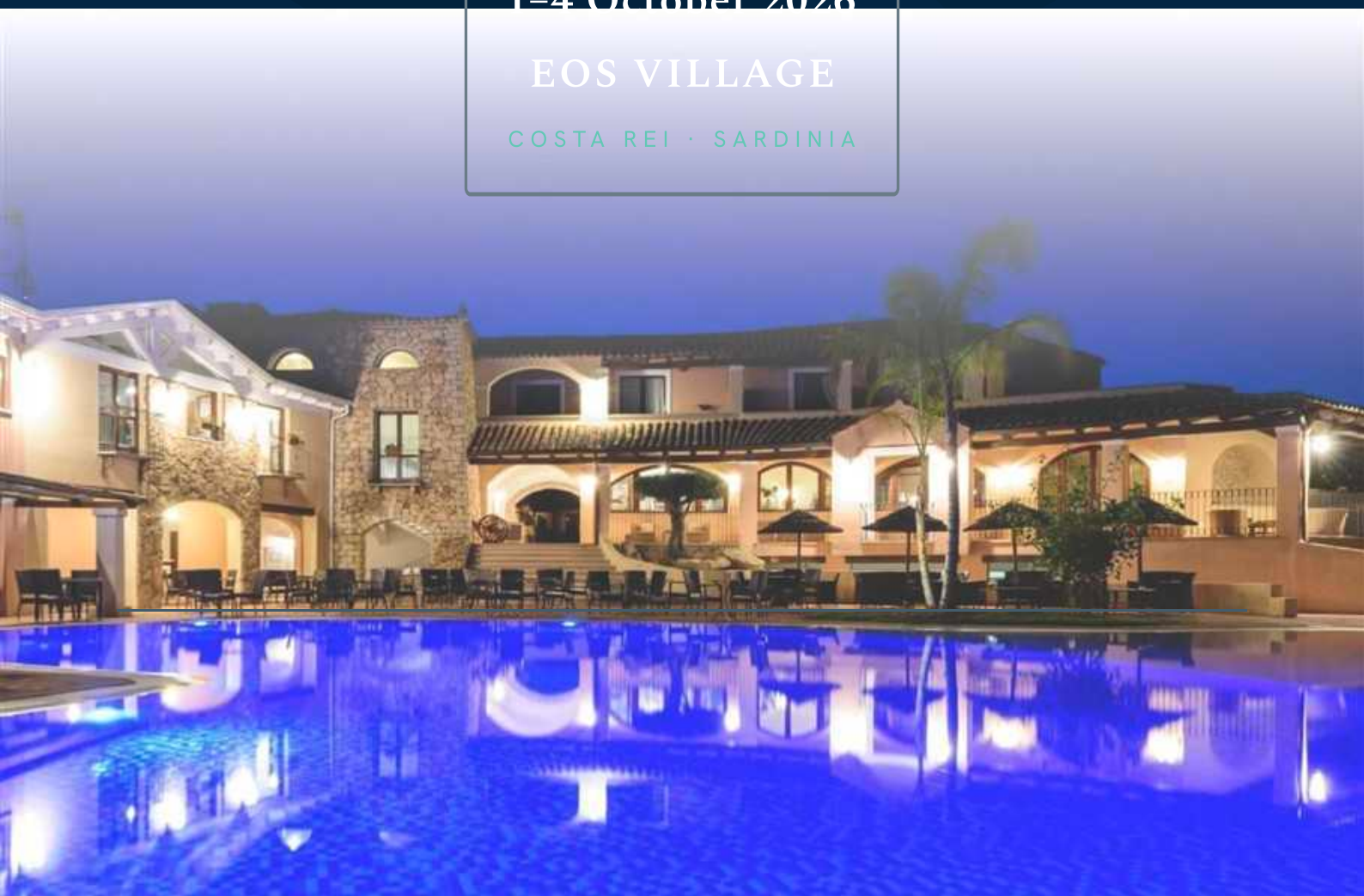

A FOCUSED TRAINING PROGRAMME ON EMERGING DEVELOPMENTS IN PLANT PROTECTION PRODUCTS.

The programme explores regulatory and scientific developments on co-formulants, biocides, inorganic compounds, risk management, risk assessment and communication in food safety.

Interactive practical sessions will provide direct experience with regulatory tools and software applied to PPP dossier preparation and risk assessment.

A whole day section will be organized within the framework of MedFoodNet - Research-to-practice network for enhanced food safety communication in the Mediterranean Region, coordinated by Istituto Zooprofilattico Sperimentale delle Venezie (IZSVe) and funded by EFSA.
